
How to easily and accurately position the heat spreader on the APU

- 1. Print this page onto a sheet of paper at full size (outer rectangle should be 152.4mm square).
- 2. Glue it to a piece of cardboard (the cardboard sleeve the APU board comes in is ideal).
- 3. Cut around the outer rectangle and then cut out the inner rectangle (using a craft knife).
- 4. Punch holes through the circles in the corner.
- 5. Place cardboard template over APU mounting plate or case (with port holes at the top).
- 6. Remove backing from heat spreader and carefully lower into position, leaving a 1 mm gap.
- 7. Remove cardboard template from plate or case.
- 8. Stick blue thermal conductive pads onto the CPU and south bridge on the underside of the APU board.
- 9. Turn board over and gently lower onto plate or case.
- 10. Gently press on the board to make sure the heat spreader makes good contact.
- 11. Screw the board to the plate or case to make sure everything stays in the correct spot.
